



## **TRANSFER CONTRACT**

### **Transfer Progression and Matriculation Requirements**

All transfer students into CHHS majors are advised by the College of Health and Human Services Advising Center and must satisfy the following requirements in order to remain in good academic standing, progress in the curriculum, and matriculate to their major department. Failure to satisfy these requirements may result in delayed progression or not being admitted into upper division of your major.

1. Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25.
  - *Students with a GPA of less than 2.0 at the end of their first semester will be placed on academic probation. All CHHS programs require a minimum GPA of 2.5 or 3.0 to be eligible to apply to the major.*
2. Pass all courses within three attempts including withdrawing from a course with a grade of "W."

### **Academic Plan Requirements**

Transfer students must complete a personal assessment and discuss with your academic advisor. You and your academic advisor will create an academic plan based on your current major, math placement score, and AP/college/transfer credits received by UNC Charlotte at the time of SOAR. Not fulfilling the requirements to develop a plan to timely graduation or to follow the advice of their academic advisor may result in delayed progression or not being admitted to upper division of your selected major in the time frame that you desire.

### **Probation and Suspension Process**

If you are placed on academic probation by the University, but nonetheless meet the condition for continued enrollment in the University, you are required to meet with an academic advisor to develop a plan of study for returning to good academic standing, and will include enrollment in the 49er Rebound program.
